## Vinyl Laminated Scrim Heat-sealable reinforcing material

### Overview

Vinyl Laminated Scrim is a .0075 thick clear vinyl film laminated to a synthetic open-mesh fabric. This reinforcing material is primarily used to reinforce hinges in looseleaf binder manufacturing due to its die-electric heat sealing ability. It may also be used as a hinge for board products, case bound books and other items.

- Base: .0075 clear vinyl film laminated to a synthetic open-mesh cloth
- Standard Width:
  - VYS27: 27" (68.58 cm) wide put up on 400 yard rolls on 3" cores
  - VYS61627: 27" (68.58 cm) wide put up on 100 yard rolls on 3" cores
  - Custom slit widths are available
- Colors: natural off-white
- Manufacturing technique: die-electric heat sealing
- Acceptable gluing to paper includes: Polyvinyl Acetate (PVA) and Hot Melt.
